

CSCC's Frozen Waterbottle Ride on New Year's Day

The Annual Frozen Water Bottle Ride will roll out on January 1st at 10:00 a.m. from BJ's Brewhouse Restaurant in University Valley Colorado at 5150 North Nevada Avenue. The shorter/easier route is a 21 mile ride with approximately 1040 feet of climbing. The ride starts out south on Nevada Ave., then switches over to Cascade passing through Colorado College and Downtown before crossing over I-25 on Colorado Ave and heading north along the west side of I-25 on Chestnut Street and through Holland Park toward the Rockrimmon area. There is a 23 mile hill climb option with approximately 1400 feet of climbing that takes you north on Centennial Blvd/Woodmen Road before returning to BJ's via Corporate Drive and North Nevada Avenue.

This annual ride was the brainchild of Bob Smith in 1987. The ride has had several different start locations during its more than 25 year history. This ride has never been cancelled, but was shortened once due to blizzard-like conditions. Join us for one of the "coolest" rides in town!
